

The Integrity Commission of Trinidad and Tobago, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and the Division of Education, Youth Affairs and Sport of the Tobago House of Assembly, challenges students to compose, invent, design or perform concepts on the topic of Integrity. The theme of the competition is

A Better Tomorrow: Do The Right Thing Always

Students of Primary and Secondary Schools who are within the qualifying ages or academic classes may enter any or all of the following categories:

- Cartoon (a Comic Strip)
- Scenario (a Skit)
- Short Story
- Poem

Entries from each Educational District will be reviewed by an eminent panel of judges who will shortlist the top entries in each category. The best three entries in each age group/ category will win prizes and present the winning pieces at an Awards Ceremony. Scenarios will be assessed at the script stage at the school, and the best will then be produced by the student/s for final judging by the panel.

The closing date for registration and entries is November 7, 2011. All entries must be submitted to the Education District Office, Ministry of Education.
