This is a competition that every student in Form One to Form Three of the Secondary School will be expected to undertake. Each student can submit no more than two entries in this competition.

Secondary School students are required to give us a Short Story not longer than 400 words or a Poem of six stanzas on the theme of Integrity. Secondary school students can compose a Scenario or design a Cartoon (or Comic Strip). With this in mind we have called this competition the “*Do Right Champions.*”
