SCHOOL COMPETITION ON THE THEME OF INTEGRITY REGISTRATION CLOSES NOVEMBER 7

This is the last call to Primary and Secondary School Students in all education districts to enter “**The Do Right Champions**” Competition.

The “Do Right Champions” competition is sponsored by the Integrity Commission in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and the Tobago House of Assembly.

The Minister of Education the Hon. Tim Gopeesingh launched the competition at the National Academy for the Performing Arts on September 27. Mr. Whitney Alfred, Secretary for Education, Sport and Youth Affairs in the Tobago House of Assembly was among the scores of School Supervisors, teachers, students and parents in attendance.

Students are required to produce Poetry, a Short Story, a Cartoon (or Comic Strip) and a Scenario script all on the theme of Integrity.

The competition is open to all students in the following age groups:

Primary School: 7-9 years and 10-12 years

Secondary School: Forms 1 – 3

Entries from each educational district will be reviewed by a panel of judges who will shortlist the top entries in each category. The best three entries in each age group/category will win prizes and present their winning items at a grand Awards Ceremony

School principals are required to collect registration materials and deposit all entries at the Ministry of Education’s District Offices. The deadline for the receipt of all entries is Monday, November 7.

Fantastic prizes are being offered to students and schools. Students can win the following: - Nintendo Wiis, iPads, iPod Touch, BMX Bicycles, Kobo E-readers, Unit Trust Vouchers, Book Vouchers, Theatre Camp sponsorships, Art Supplies and Jansport Book Bags. Schools are eligible to win SMARTboards, a projector, sporting and musical equipment.
